ENGLISH AND PERSPECTIVES: English is a required course. To be prepared for ENG3U a student should have a grade of 60% or higher in Grade 10 Academic English. ENG3U is a prerequisite for ENG4U, which is required for university entrance. Students are also required to take a perspectives course. Next year, the plan is for each student to take a English and Perspectives two-credit course (block) that includes a major focus on World Views. **CHECK ONE**

MATH: Math is a required course. To be prepared for MCR3U a student should have a grade of 70% or higher in Grade 10 Academic Math. For MCF3M, students should have a grade of 60% or higher in Grade 10 Academic Math (MPM2D) or 75% or higher in Grade 10 Applied Math. **CHECK ONE**
