ENGLISH: English is a required course. Students must take ENG4U in order to be eligible for university entrance. Students may take either ENG4C or ENG4U to be eligible for college entrance. **CHECK ONE**

PERSPECTIVES: At present, all students will be required to take Challenge and Change in Society, University/College as their Perspective course. This course will be taught in conjunction with English. However, in the event that this does not occur, students should **CHECK ONE** of the following.

Family Studies U/C (HHS4M) Philosophy University (HZT4U) Philosophy Open (HZB3O)

OTHER COURSES: Students who plan to apply for university must earn at least FIVE grade 12 university/college (U/C or M) or university (U) credits besides the required ENG4U chosen under English. Students who plan to apply for college or apprenticeship should be careful to choose courses that will allow them to maximize their college or apprenticeship options.

CHOOSE AT LEAST 9 MORE COURSES (spare is included) from ALL of the following options. This will mean that you have at least 11 course selections. This will allow us to know what you would desire in the event more than one of your desired courses is scheduled in the same period or is not offered. Do NOT worry about order of preference at this time.

MATH: Students must earn either a grade 11 or 12 math credit. While a math credit is not required in grade 12, TDChristian highly recommends that all students take a math course as many apprenticeship, college, and university programs have a math requirement. Often students who do not take math find out they need it later and take math independently, or at night or summer school.

SCIENCE: Students must earn either a grade 11 or 12 science credit. While science is not required in grade 12, TDChristian recommends that students seriously consider taking science. Check apprenticeship, college, and university programs you are interested in to see if they have specific science requirements.
